Gifford Community Meeting 45th Street Beautification Project

BACKGROUND

- 2002 Gifford Neighborhood Plan called for 45th Street resurfacing and streetscape improvements
- Resurfacing and limited curbing improvements made west of 43rd
 Avenue (2011)
- Streetscape: various funding amounts programmed; not designed and no improvements installed

- 2013/2014: Gifford Neighborhood Plan Update included project plans and funding identified
- Design plans begun (grant and County funds)
- March 3, 2014 PCLG public meeting: landscape plans using \$350,000 budget presented

- Community Feedback: more needs to be done
 - Curbing improvements needed
 - Turn lane in front of GMS needed
 - More landscaping and funding needed
- Feedback led to revisions to the draft GNP

- Changes made to GNP update
 - 45th Street Beautification for "Gifford's Main Street"
 - Phase 1 (2016) East of 43rd Avenue
 - widened shoulders/bike lanes both sides
 - Streetlight in-filling
 - Curbing certain portions
 - Re-surface side streets
 - Landscaping
 - Turn lane in front of GMS

- Phase 2 (2018) East of 43rd Avenue
 - Culvert portions of canal
 - Landscaping
- Re-surface 45th Street from 43rd Avenue to US 1 (2020)
